





Description

The **Filament Tape Dispenser H121** is a lightweight, all metal, hand held unit. Featuring a braking device, the **H121** enables the operator to apply tension to the tape. The **H121** is useful for a wide variety of carton reinforcing, bundling, and on-the-spot box sealing and masking applications.





Loading Instructions

- 1) Lift up on brake (A) and start roll over back edge of dispenser's tape roll grip (see arrow **Figure 2**). Push tape roll forward and press down to fully mount tape roll.



- 2) Pull 3 to 4 inches [80 to 100mm] of tape from roll while ensuring that the inner tape edge is folding over by applying tension to the roll brake. Pull on lead end tab to thread tape through and over roll spring (B) (see arrow **Figure 3**).



Operating Instructions

- 1) Pull out the desired length of tape and apply it to the side of the box (as shown in **Figures 4 and 5**).



- 2) Pull the dispenser across the box top (over the center seam). Apply hand pressure on the brake to provide tension on the tape web to obtain a tight seal (**Figure 6**). Buff the tape down with the opposite hand (as shown in **Figures 6 and 7**).



- 3) Continue the tape web down the side of the box to the desired length. To cut the tape, push down and rotate the dispenser slightly (**Figure 7**). Buff the tape down by hand.



WARNING

- To reduce the risk associated with sharp blade hazards:
 - Keep hands and fingers away from tape cutoff blades. The blades are extremely sharp.

How to Replace the Blade

1. To replace the used blade, remove the mounting screws (**Figure 8**).
2. Install the replacement blade with the beveled cutting edge up and positioned to front of dispenser.
3. Reinstall the mounting screws to secure the blade.


